



- Socks
- Trainers (not plimsolls)

Hair, Earrings and Jewellery

- all year round -

Hair

- All hair longer than shoulder length must be tied up
- Hair accessories should be purple, white, gold, black or grey
- Hair should be age appropriate; of a natural colour and not involve shaven sides, obvious 'steps' and/or razor lines

Earrings

- Small studs only (plain or jeweled)
- No earrings worn on PE days (they will not be able to take part in PE unless your child can remove the earrings themselves)

Jewellery

- Children are welcome to wear watches (without alarms)
 analogue clock face preferable
- No i-watches / smart watches to be worn at school
- No necklaces, bracelets etc unless for religious purposes
