Information for parents: in the event of school closure

Dear Parents/ carers,

As you will be aware, the Coronavirus is very much at the top of the news currently - including various countries responses to the outbreak.

As a school, we follow information and guidance given to us through Public Health UK and the Department for Education. Should they direct schools to close (as a measure to try and halt the spread and outbreak of the virus) we will be required to follow that direction. Therefore, we would like to make it clear now what would happen in such a situation; so that we are all prepared if it does happen. **Currently, we have had no instruction to close. If we do, we will inform you.**

In the event of a school closure:

- Class teachers will send a message to their classes via school email, to outline the tasks to complete that day.
- Your child will have a daily phonics task, a maths task and a project task to complete. In addition, your child needs to complete daily reading.
- If you have any questions regarding the set tasks, please send these to <u>info@cambridgeschool.hants.sch.uk</u>, a monitored email address.
- Parents are responsible for ensuring they and their families followed the guidelines and directions from the government and Public Health UK during this time.

We hope this provides some clarity and comfort during what is quite an uncertain time for all. Please rest assured we would only close if directed to do so. In the meantime, we continue to follow guidance and encourage good hygiene amongst our school community.
