

Comprehension Questions

As fluency develops, we focus on the children's understanding of what they have read and their responses to the text. We encourage children to develop comprehension skills by thinking about the following <u>aspects</u> using engaging characters:

- Victor <u>Vocabulary</u>- Identifying new vocabulary and discussing its meaning, talking about the author's choice of words and using this to understand the text.
- <u>Sequencing</u> Suki- Identifying and explaining the sequence of events in texts.
- Rex <u>*Retriever*</u>- Identifying and explaining key aspects of fiction and nonfiction texts, such as characters, events, titles and information.
- <u>Inference</u> Iggy- 'Reading between the lines' and looking for clues to gain a deeper understanding of the text.
- <u>Predicting</u> Pip- Predict what might happened on the basis of what has been read so far.
