### Home Learning

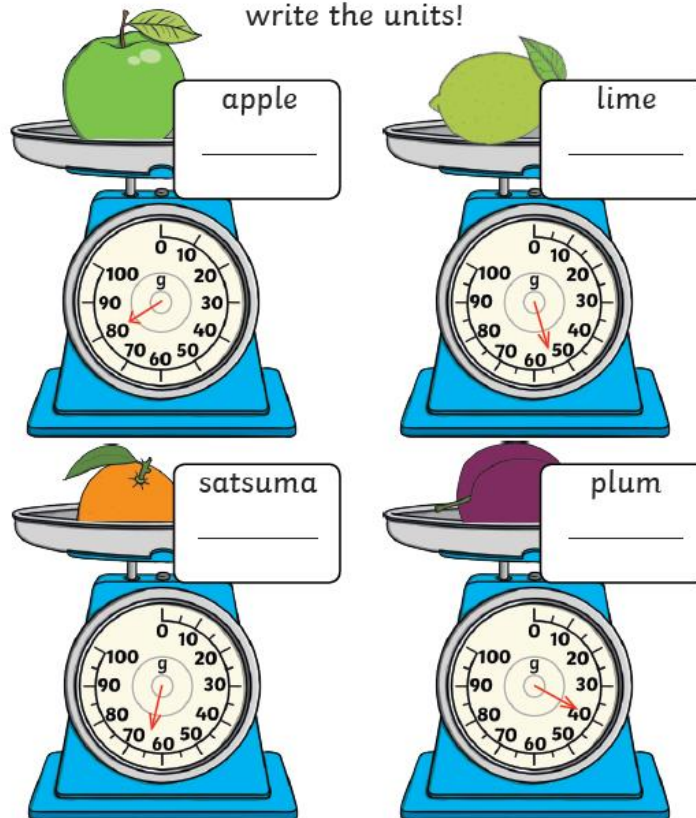
Please continue to read daily for 15 minutes. Ensure you record it in your child's reading record so they can take part in the reading challenge.

Kim puts two objects on the scales.

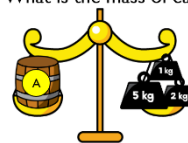


The cube is lighter, because it is smaller.
