Children will:

- Write sentences with a focus on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- Retell stories with prosody.
- Learn about nouns, verbs and adjectives.

- Make number bonds.
- Add by using resources and by counting on.
- Make addition number stories.

Science

Children will:

- Learn about the seasons and the different types of weather.
- Carrying out experiments to measure different types of weather.

Children will:

- Learn about the countries that make up the United Kingdom.
- Identify differences between cities, towns and villages.
- Identify and discuss different landmarks.

Children will:

- Developing confidence and responsibility and making the most of abilities.
- Preparing to play active role as a citizen.
- Developing a healthy, safer lifestyle.
- Develop good relationship and respecting the differences between people.

- Discuss the work of famous artists.

- Learn the rules to help them keep safe online.
- Learn about what information needs to be kept private.

Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

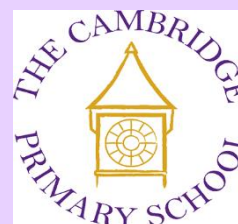
Children will:
