

RECEPTION

Autumn 2 - What happens when I fall asleep?
This term's learning focuses on day and night, we will discuss and learn about the solar system, nocturnal animals and people who help us at night.



Communication, Literacy and Language

Children will:

- Focus on 3 key texts about night time and the solar system.
- Learn to discuss a topic using new vocabulary.
- Will listen, talk and respond to books recalling ideas and responding to questions.

<u>Maths</u>

Children will:

- Represent numbers 1-10 using a ten frame. They will be introduced to addition using a 5 frame.
- Learn about lengths, heights, and capacity.
- Recap repeating patterns and 2D shapes.

Literacy

Children will:

- Continue the Little Wandle phonics programme, learning Phase 2 and Phase 3 sounds.
- Listen, hear and write sounds in CVC words.
- Continue reading sessions, focusing on decoding and blending sounds.

Understanding the world

Children will:

- Make observations and comments about their immediate environment using simple vocabulary.
- Observe similarities between the past and present.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

Children will:

- Know and explain the school rules and demonstrate these.
- Be confident in using the colour monster and identifying emotions.
- Continue to work on playing cooperatively and learn to demonstrate good learning and play behaviours.

Computing

Children will:

 Continue to explore the interactive whiteboard to extend their learning.

Religion and World Views

Children will:

- Begin to talk about own experiences.
- Recognise special times and events in own lives.
