Spring 1–This term learning our topic is called ‘Rioting Romans’

English

Children will:

- Write a short narrative about a chariot race
- Learn about what fronted adverbials are and how to apply our knowledge of this in our writing
- Learn how to use apostrophes for possession

Maths

Children will learn how to:

- To multiply a one digit number by a 2 digit number with renaming
- To divide a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number with renaming
- Solve word problems involving multiplication and division
- Write lengths in mm, cm and m
- Compare and convert lengths

Science

Children will learn about:

- Sources of light
- Learn to distinguish between a light source and a reflection
- Learn which surfaces have the best reflective properties
- Learn about parts of the eye and their functions
- Learn about how light travels and how we see it.

History

Children will:

- Learn facts about the Celts
- Discover what Roman soldiers wore and carried and how this compares to Celtic warriors
- Learn about the Celtic rebellion against the Romans led by Boudicca
- Examine Roman villa complexes and the way of life in a countryside villa in Britain.

PSHE

Children will:

- Know what dream and ambitions are important to them and how to achieve them
- Know how they can best overcome learning challenges
- Know what their own strengths are as a learner
- Can manage feeling linked to facing obstacles.

Art

Children will:

- Explore and discuss mosaics in Art form
- To design and make a Roman inspired mosaic
- To create mosaics using different mediums
- To make a mosaic using tiles

Computing

Children will:

- Learn how to use the cut, copy and paste tools
- Resize graphics within a document
- Learn how to use spell check

PE

Children will improve their physical development by:

- Learning seven gymnastic shapes and to perform these shapes as jumps
- Learn five gymnastic balances
- To travel in different ways
- Perform sequences using equipment

Religion & World Views (RAW)

Children will:

- Learn about making choices through the concept of ‘Temptation’
- Enquire about what it means to do the right thing
- Read stories about Jesus being led to temptation
- Evaluate how Christians make choices

French (MFL)

Children will learn how to:

- Recognise, recall and spell up to ten instruments in French
- Learn to say and write ‘I play an instrument’.

Music

Children will learn how to:

- Play recorders or boom whackers in unison.
- Learn to use rhythm and tempo when composing their own pieces.
