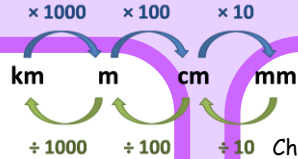


# YEAR 4 Summer Term This term learning focuses on investigating Anglo Saxon and explore Vikings

## English

- Children will:
- Explore the story of How to train your dragon.
  - Create a play script to perform to their friends.
  - Noun phrases
  - Speech- inverted commas
  - Similies
  - Commas for subordination
  - Fronted adverbials

## Maths



- Children will:
- Convert units of measure from larger to smaller.
  - Pupils will also be taught how to measure perimeter using centimeters and millimeters.
  - They will use their knowledge of measures to solve problems involving all three aspects of Measurement.

## Science

- Children will:
- Describe the basic structure of the ear
  - Establish that sounds get fainter as the distance increases
  - Know that sound travels through solids and liquids as well as air
  - Investigate the effectiveness of different materials to muffle sound
  - Understand what pitch is

## Geography/ History

- Children will:
- To identify reasons for the Anglo-Saxon migration
  - To investigate Saxon life in Aldershot & Farnham.
  - To identify the effects of the changing beliefs of the Anglo-Saxons.
  - To compare sources of evidence for the Anglo-Saxon period.
  - To determine qualities of Anglo-Saxon leadership.
  - To conclude whether the Anglo-Saxons lived in a Dark Age.

## Physical Education (PE)

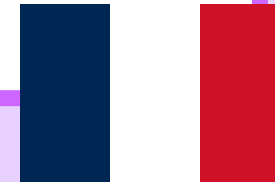
- Children will:
