

RECEPTION

Summer 2 - Do cows drink milk?

We will base our learning around a farmyard theme. We will be exploring farmyard animals, learning all about food and crops and how the animals are cared for on a farm.



Communication, Literacy and Language

Children will:

- Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.
- Listen, talk about and respond to stories and rhymes with comments, questions and recall key event, characters and settings.
- Talk about elements of a topic using newly introduced vocabulary and a range of conjunctions and tenses,

Maths

Children will:

- Have a deep understanding of number to 10, including the composition of each number;
- Subitise up to 5;
- Automatically recall (without reference to rhymes, counting or other aids) number bonds up to 5 (including subtraction facts) and some number bonds to 10, including double facts.
- Verbally count beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system;
- Compare quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognising when one quantity is greater than, less than or the same as the other quantity;
- Explore and represent patterns within numbers up to 10.

Literacy

Children will:

- Talk about and respond to stories, rhymes and poetry; recalling, sequencing and anticipating key events some as exact repetition and some in their own words.
- Begin to interpret stories, rhymes and poetry; making suggestions for actions and events (images and text).
- Talk about and respond with questions to non-fiction books; recalling some facts with increasing explanation and vocabulary in response to questions.
- Read sentences made up of words with taught sounds and common exception words.

Understanding the World

Children will:

- Talk about similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things (Locational Knowledge).
- Talk about things like plants, animals, natural and round objects.
- Create simple representations of people and objects.
- Use my senses and look closely.

Religion and World Views

Children will:

- Begin to talk about similarities and differences in relation to themselves and others within the key concept.
- Recognise special times and events in own lives.
- Begin to evaluate human experience of the concept by talking about it in simple terms.

Physical Education

Children will:

- Be focusing on learning a range of skills to help them play and engage with outdoor games such as football, netball, rounders, cricket and playground games.
- Sports day practice.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will:

- Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, beginning to use form and function.
- Create their own work in art and design and to talk about their work to peers and adults, talking confidently about the process they used.
- Use the role play area props confidently during roleplay in narratives or stories.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development


Children will:

Know and explain the reasons for rules and to solve conflicts with some support.


