Next week

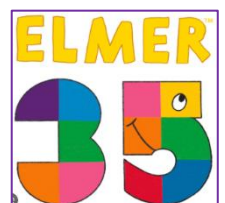
English: Next week in English, we will be assessing our Y3 learning so far, and planning our own invented diary entry.

Maths: Next week in maths, we will be assessing our Y3 learning so far.

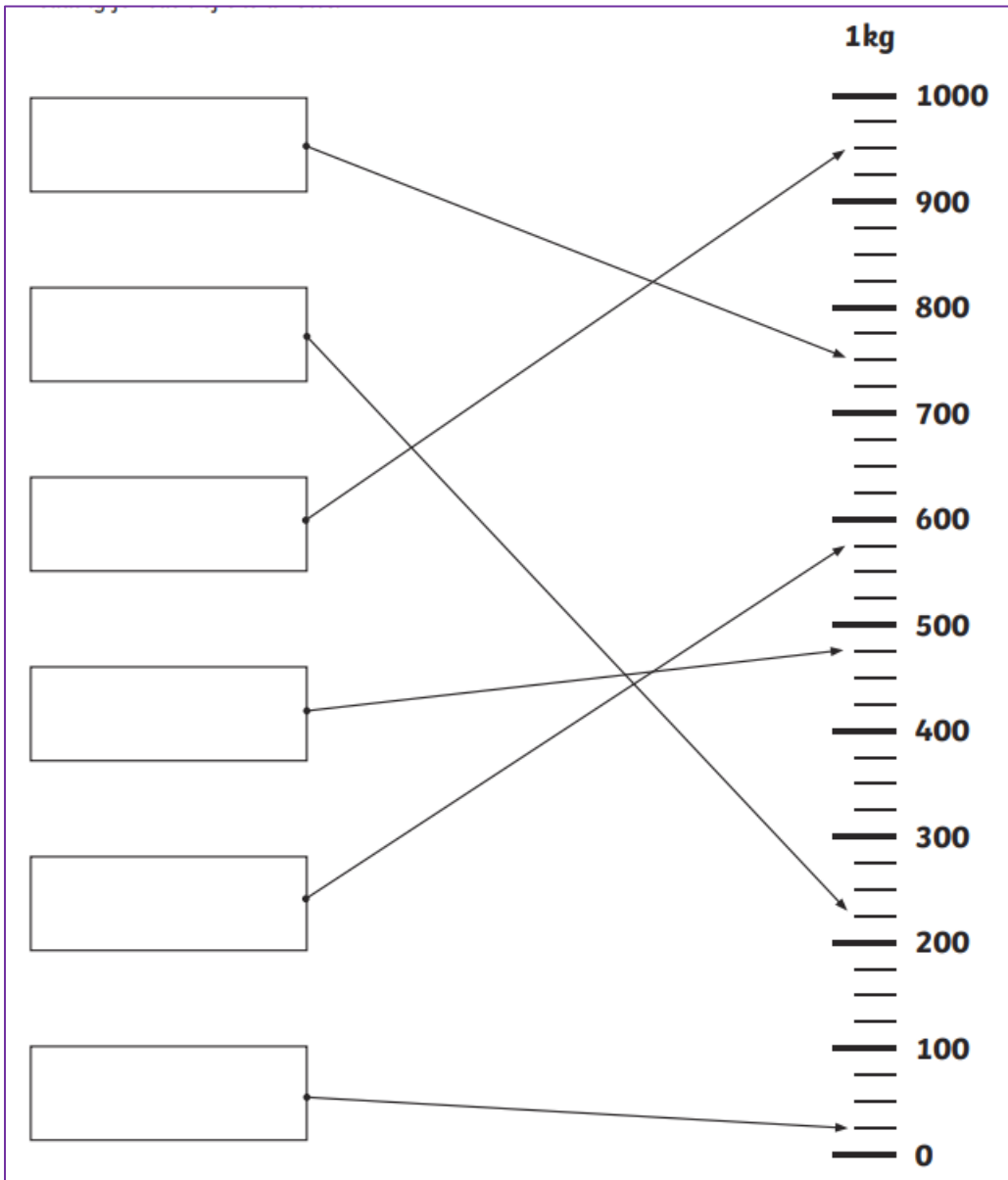
Topic: Next week in history, we will be learning about Roman baths.

- Next week is assessment week where we will be checking our progress in reading, grammar, spelling and maths.

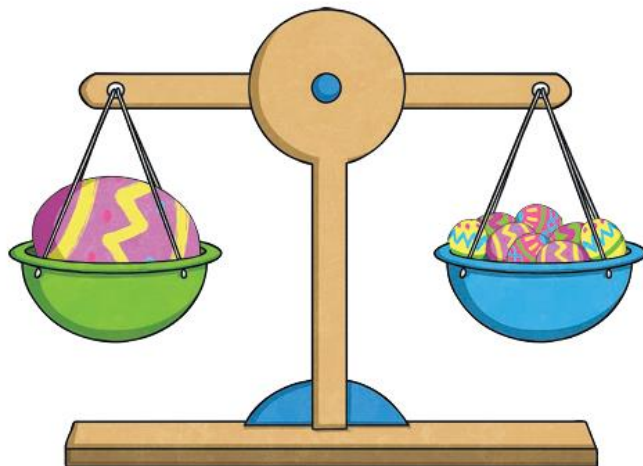
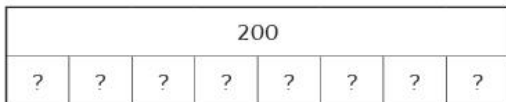


HOMWORK
