2. **Blend the sounds** from left to right to read the words.

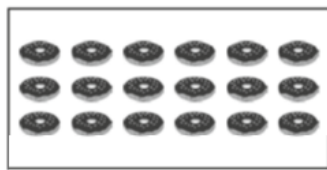
