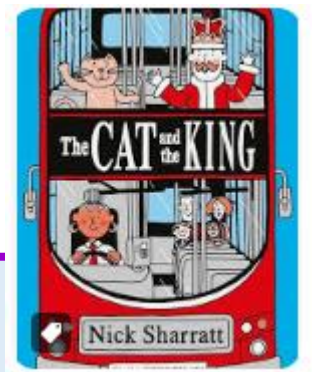
Beech and Chestnut - Thursday 19th September - Trip to PTI Passout parade
