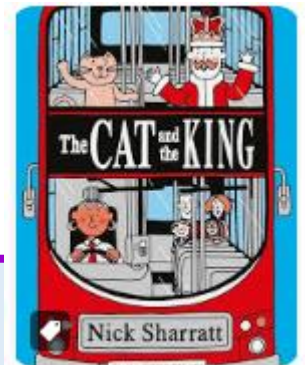
Important Dates:













Maths: We are learning more about the place value of a 2-digit number.
